Bruins Heading To Arizona For Two Competitions

Tonight, ASU, at the bottom of the PAC 10, will battle against UCLA in a little-anticipated [NCAA gambling](#) game before the Bruins play the Wildcats on Saturday. But don't let the sorry state of ASU's basketball program fool you. The team is coming off of a astonishing upset win in spite of 2 of their top players suffering from injuries. The squad put together a victory with some lesser-known freshmen, whilst UCLA experienced a hard overtime upset.

The squad now travels to Arizona to take on ASU on Thursday and then the Number 10 Wildcats on Saturday in [basketball gambling](#).
