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[Football probabilities](#) odds makers remain impressed and shocked by the resurgent Tampa Bay Buccaneers who are having unexpected success with the lines. NFL [sport betting](#) anticipations continue to expand for the Atlanta Falcons as they are one of the foremost favorites with the NFL prospects to win the NFC title.

The Atlanta Falcons will host the Tampa Bay Buccaneers on Sunday with kickoff established for 1:05 PM Eastern. The sportsbook opened with Atlanta as an 8 point fave and with an over/under of 44.5. Fox will air the competition.

Sunday's game will see first place in the National Football Conference on the line since both the Atlanta Falcons and the Bucs Buccaneers have 5-2 records. Still, the Falcons are receiving more value at the sportsbook since they are 8-point home faves.

Tampa Bay has a record of 5-2 straight up as well as 4-3 with the [NFL Football Gambling](#) lines. The Bucs have won three of their last four games including 2 consecutive and are coming off a 38-35 upset win at Arizona. Buccaneers is evened up with Atlanta for first place in the National Football Conference South Division and has covered all 3 of their road games this year.

The Buccaneers defense has been unstable and rates 25th for points permitted but second year qb Josh Freeman has shown marked progress with an 87.1 qb rating and an 8/3 touchdown/interception ratio. LeGarrette Blount has a 5.2 yards per carry average from the backfield.

Coach Raheem Morris has gone on record as proclaiming that his team is the top in the National Football Conference, and it's totally feasible that he's right. It is not always simple, and it's not always pretty, however the Bucs are finding strategies to win games. With this competition vs the Falcons, they're going to have a shot to demonstrate their coach right.

Atlanta has a record of 5-2 straight up and 4-3 with the Football wagering lines. The Falcons are arriving off a bye week that came after a 39-32 home pay out against Cincinnati. Atlanta ranks 6th overall, for total offense and 10th on defense for points allowed.

Quarterback Matt Ryan has an 89.6 Quarterback rating and a 12/5 TD/INT percentage. Running back Michael Turner has a 4.5 yards per carry average.

This is going to be a lot to ask for the Bucs to win in Atlanta vs a more fundamentally sound Atlanta Falcons squad. Atlanta must be set to play, nonetheless, as the Bucs have proven to be a annoying and opportunistic squad. But the Buccaneers should be prepared to defend themselves versus an Atlanta team that might be a little bit insulted at Morris's comments.

Buccanneers has covered the football lines 5 sequential times as a road dog while Atlanta has covered 7 of their

previous 9 as a home favorite. Bucs has fallen under the total in 9 of their past ten games versus the National Football Conference whilst Atlanta has gone below the total in 9 of their past 13 competitions in total.

Tampa Bay has paid out in 8 of their previous ten trips to Atlanta and this series has gone below the total 4 consecutive times.

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
