NFL Gambling – Chicago Bears Versus Bills From Toronto

Chicago Bears 4-3 - In some way the Bears are 4-3 even though quarterback Jay Cutler is taking a whipping each week. Offensive coordinator Mike Martz proceeds to call plays that put Cutler in jeopardy and he gets pounded every week. The Chicago Bears had a bye last week and Cutler required the rest. He was sacked 4 times and threw 4 interceptions to DeAngelo Hall in the loss to the Washington Redskins. Cutler has been sacked a league-leading total of 27 times, 19 in the previous 3 competitions. The Chicago offense has been terrible lately with Cutler taking sack following sack. Chicago is terrible on 3rd down with a league-worst 18-per cent conversion rate. Whether the bye week will help Chicago is up for discussion but we will see on Sunday.

Tough Fortune Bills - There's not a team in the NFL that is competing harder than the Bills and receiving nothing from it. Buffalo lost in ot on Sunday for the 2nd consecutive week. They looked to have beaten the Kansas city chiefs in overtime but Kansas City head coach Todd Haley called a timeout right prior to the kick and Rian Lindell missed the second one. The Chiefs were able to drive down and Ryan Succop hit the game champ for Kansas City and the Bills left with yet another nasty loss. Buffalo is the 4th squad in league history to lose on the road in overtime in consecutive weeks. The Bills are now off to the third-worst start in team history.

Series History - The Chicago Bears have won 4 of the seven matchups in this NFL wagering series with the last meeting arriving in 2006. The Chicago Bears won 40-7 at home that year. The Bills won the earlier 2 meetings in 2000 and 2002, both in Buffalo.
