# **Preview For Tuesday Evening's Musketeers-La Salle NCAAB Game**

Xavier is one of those clubs that keep profitable matches, despite having poor performances in a variety of areas. In some way, they find a way to get it carried out, and they've the successful record to demonstrate it, but they are not playing solid basketball in a lot of of their victories. They will have an opportunity to improve the fundamentals playing La Salle on Tuesday evening, however.

The Xavier Musketeers are presently rated 25th, with a record of 20-6, 11-1, and have won twelve of their last 13 matches. On Saturday, they beat Fordham 79-72, in spite of being out-rebounded 38-32. They were also scored more than in second-chance points 14-7. This game could have been among the closest calls for Fordham, which hasn't won a match in the league in the last two years in [college basketball gambling](#).

Despite their win, the poor performance cost Xavier on place in the polls, falling from 24th to 25th. As they take on La Salle this week, the Musketeers will be trying to boost their total performance, rather than squeaking out a victory in spite of bad statistics, bad shooting, and weak rebounding. And La Salle should give them a great opportunity.

Xavier has won their last 4 meetings with La Salle by an average of 12.5 points, so there could not be a lot of a challenge. Jerrell Williams of La Salle averages 14.0 points per competition, but merely 9.0 in the last 3 contests against Xavier. He landed 27 in a close loss to George Washington on Saturday, nonetheless, so he will be worth observing this Tuesday.

This was La Salle's 2nd consecutive loss, and they've let go of four of their last 5 matches. They were down by 18 points in the 2nd half and came back to close to within one point of George Washington with :26 left on the clock, but only may not get the position accomplished and pull out a win in [basketball gambling](#).

La Salle has not beaten a Top 25 squad since their March 3, 2001, win versus No. 18 Saint Joseph.
