He threw four Touchdown passes and the Seahawks became the 1st team in Football history with a losing record to win a playoff match. And it wasn't a fluke. Seattle outcompeted the Saints and earned to win. Seattle scored more than Drew Brees and the Saints and looked like a team that had to win. Brees concluded a playoff-record 39 passes in 60 endeavors for 404 yards and 2 TDs but the New Orleans Saints had no running game and the defense couldn't stop Seattle.
