Sportsbook Website – Substantial Upset As Browns Shock Reigning Champ Saints

One of the greatest upsets in a long time happened on Sunday as the Cleveland Browns not merely covered the Nfl lines at the [football sportsbook](#) website, they won outright at New Orleans against the Super Bowl champion New orleans saints. And the Browns only did not win by a point; they owned the New orleans saints and got a 30-17 win that stunned most bettors at the sportsbook.

This is a game for which the [sportsbook](#) was forecasting the Saints to be a far away victor. They were getting 13 points in the home game against the Browns. Of course there is lots of pressure on the Saints to perform this season following they won the Super Bowl a year ago. And sure, it hasn't been a excellent season for them to date. But still, nobody could have viewed this coming. The Browns are now 2-5 and the Saints are 4-3.

The win may be partly attributed to coach Eric Mangini's match plan, which involved a defensive tactic that kept the Saints confused and pressured them into uncharacteristic turnovers and penalties throughout the game. The Browns disguised their intentions and this actually threw off Brees.

Brees Throws 4 Picks - Quarterback Drew Brees threw 4 interceptions, two of which were returned by Cleveland's David Bowens for touchdowns. The Cleveland browns won despite the fact that Cleveland qb Colt McCoy threw for only 74 yards. Peyton Hillis won the only offensive Td for the Browns on a four-yard run. It was the Browns defense that won the game as they puzzled Brees all day. Bowens had two interceptions whereas Scott Fujita and Sheldon Brown furthermore had interceptions. They sacked Brees 3 times.

New Orleans Never Led In Points - Usually when you get a huge point spread shocker it's a late victory by the longshot. Not this time around. This time around the Browns directed from start to finish and won as a major longshot both straight up and on the cash line at the internet sportsbook. The New orleans saints pulled to within 20-10 in the 4th quarter but Cleveland picked off Brees again. Brees has currently thrown 10 interceptions this season after throwing simply 11 all of last year. The New orleans saints outgained Cleveland 394-211 but they continually made mistakes. Brees was 37 of 56 for 356 yards and two touchdowns but he made far too a lot of errors.

New orleans saints 4-3 SU, 2-5 ATS - Is the Super Bowl champion curse happening again this year in terms of the point spread? It sure appears that way as the New orleans saints have been a point spread catastrophe, going 2-5 ATS. New Orleans is still above .500 straight up but they are not a squad you want to take at this time versus the probabilities at the sportsbook website. It's not going to get any simpler next week for the New orleans saints as they host the Pittsburgh steelers. If the Saints thought the Cleveland defense was hard they have not seen anything yet. The Pittsburgh steelers will really put the stress on Brees this week as they appear to get the road win.
