The Fight For The AFC Championship - New England Patriots Versus New York Jets

This Sunday at 4:30PM Eastern Standard, CBS will feature pro football playoff year Divisional Playoffs. In a true fight for the AFC Championship title we will see the New England Patriots vs. the Jets.

The leading seed Patriots are the favorites for Super Bowl 45. That's a practically 15% difference! In practically half of their regular season games this year they were able to keep their opposition under control and under 14 points. This defensive strategy was additionally apparent in last weekend's wildcard game versus the Colts. The Jets were able to hold the Colts to a mere 16 points. When thinking about your Jets bets, note that just one team has ever hosted the Colts under 17 points. The big questions to ponder when betting on the divisional playoffs are what is more effective, the Jets' defense, or the Pats' home turf edge?

Let's check out their regular season record. The Pats and the New York Jets met two times this year. In their last matchup the Patriots took down the Jets at home in Week 13, the final score was an embarrassing 45-3. However the New York Jets embarrassed the Pats in Week 2 when they shut them out for the final thirty, with the final score at 28-14. This was one of only 2 New England Patriots losses in the 2010 Football regular season. Sportsbook posts the New England Patriots as the minus 8.5 point home favorites with the total over/under at 45. The New York Jets have stepped up their match thus far in the past year, pressuring the Colts to rush the ball more than passing it, despite the fact that the Colts had averaged 42.4 pass endeavors and 24.6 rush efforts per game this year. When gambling on this Super Bowl matchup note that the Patriots additionally have MVP prospect Tom Brady, by most accounts the best quarterback in pro football.
