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# **Wagering On Football Sunday Night - Broncos Vs St Louis Rams**

The Denver Broncos sponsor the Rams this Thanksgiving weekend. The Rams are presently in 2nd place in the National Football Conference West with 4-6-0, and the Broncos are lagging at the bottom of the AFC West with a 3-7-0 record. The Broncos are coming off an ego crippling loss to their AFC West enemies the San Diego Chargers and in the light of the match they're destined to be looking to answer back. The only issue with the Denver Broncos is that they only don't have the talent they once had. Most of their expertise is thriving on other clubs and the Denver Broncos are a gutted shell of what they one time were.

The Rams offense has progressed well under 1st year quarterback Sam Bradford. They are a well balanced offense that will move the ball versus a number of the better defenses in football. The running game featuring Steven Jackson has yet to explode, the St Louis Rams are averaging only 105 yards per game. The Broncos defense is top on the edges with Champ Bailey among the better shut down corners in pro football. Where Denver can be defeated is on the ground. The Broncos are allowing over 143 yards per competition to NFL rushers, which is one of the worst numbers in pro football. The pass rush is also subpar for the Denver Broncos and can be tracked back to the losing of Elvis Dumervil. The St Louis Rams offense will have the advantage over the Denver Broncos defense.

The statistics for the Broncos offense can be tricky when arranging a match plan. Kyle Orton ranks second among passing leaders but the majority of his statistics have been skewed. The passing attack for the Broncos averages almost 300 yards per competition but almost all of these yards build up when they're coming from behind and the opposing squad is shuttling in second chain defenders.

The running game for the Broncos has been omitted most of the season but Knowshon Moreno is back and healthy. The Broncos are presently averaging only under 80 yards per match but with Moreno back in the rotation he ought to manage to ring up some major games on the ground.

The St Louis Rams defense is average however they will have a few of the superior young expertise in pro football on the defensive side of the ball. They are smothering the foes running game and are not allowing more than 100 yards per match and are also keeping the oppositions passing attack under 230 yards per competition.

Over the middle the Rams are mucking up the passing lanes and over the top, their corners may run with the greatest route runners in the NFL. The best competitor on defense is certainly James Laurinaitis but they're establishing expertise in all aspects of their defense. Soon the St Louis Rams will be the leader of this week National Football Conference West division and that may be as soon as this season.
