Next is the 27in Babolat Pure Drive. For those real performers, this is the perfect racquet for them. This offers stability, control and good speed and to mention that this racquet only weighs 11 ounces. It could immediately collect the ball and sending it to your opponent with ferocious speed and force being a 100 sq. Effective for slice shots, the racquet has been strung at 50-57 pounds and the tension can be increased to 65 pounds for better control. Great manoeuvrability and great performance.

Last but definitely not the least, Andy Roddicks, Babolat Pure Drive Plus. It will definitely make your game more easier because of the power that this great racquet will give. The 1/2 inch extra length added onto Pure Drive makes players utilizing Pure Drive Plus to conform to swinging the bat sooner. Nevertheless, the control, the spin and additional power on serves gives Pure Drive Plus a minimum of four stars on five.
