Fly fishing is a touch distinct from fishing which has a spinning rod and reel. When flyfishing, the angler runs on the heavy line to cast an incredibly light fly (a lure that appears as being a fly). In spin fishing, the angler runs on the light line to cast a much heavier lure.

By design, a fly is too light to be cast, and thus simply follows the unfurling of the properly cast fly line, which can be heavier and tapered and therefore more castable than lines found in other types of fishing.
