Adams Speedline Fast 11 Driver Review

Adams Golf has created just another generation of powerful aerodynamic clubs. This is our [Adams Speedline Fast 11 driver review](#) in addition to how does this club look like a Dandy. From the beautiful blue color completely down to the precise specifications of a club that was honed from generation in order to generation. In this [golf clubs review](#), we are going over what it takes to be the most effective in it's class.

As an alternative to following what other team manufacturers are doing to boost their generations clubs, Adams golf went a step further and added revolutionary Velocity Slots on the crown and sole of the club. The Speedline Fast 11 driver is actually 35% more aerodynamic because the airflow stays attached in the entire swing. Erasing Move and turbulence. This increased clubhead velocity means a gain of at the least 6 yards of put in carry distance.

This team is nothing short connected with awesome. It's easy to hit, faster and more forgiving. If you're like your game needs improving, this club will do you right. 6 more yards is not a small change in the game like golf. It can really change lives. Let's see what other's must say:

"I got this club after taking one of the demos out for the round and was very pleased with it. I opted for a 9.5* Stiff as I generate a fair degree of clubhead speed with my taller frame. Before obtaining, I debated going with the F10 or the F11. After reading about a lot of the shaft issues with your Aldila Wasabi shafts, I went F11. The team is long and relatively forgiving, however, after with regards to 100 swings, I appeared to be left holding a Voodoo shaft and watching my head fly fifty yards downrange. Adams quickly sent me another car owner, however, after hearing via our company VP that another store had their demo break within even fewer swings, I'm a little bit concerned that the Speedline heads aren't matching well with your Aldila shafts. Adams has done a terrific job of responding to it's customers in the many reviews I read within the F10's and my knowledge was similar, however, vendor beware, you may obtain a two piece driver if going with the Voodoo shaft. I truly do like the club a lot and the appearance of the Voodoo shaft over your Matrix Ozik, though if it happens again, I may opt for the Ozik shaft as that apparently solved all issues with the F10's..."
