Be able to Calculate Your Golf Handicap

Hey! It's me, from [golf clubs review](#)? If you'd like a great golf driver, that's the place to receive it! Alright, for today we can go over how to calculate your golf handicap. That is the confusing topic for a lot of people. So I'm taking the liberty of setting the record straight.

Your local Golf club Committee will take on this responsibility of Calculating your Golf Handicap to suit your needs. However, most of them will require you to submit at least 5 Score Cards, totally completed, with all the Gross Scores marked down, so they can offer you an initial Golf Handicap. When these Score Cards are from different Golf Courses, then you should make a note of the following:

The Standard Scratch Score of the Course - which is the measure of the playing ability of your Golf Course for the Scratch Golfer under normal course and weather conditions.

The Slope Rating of the Course - which indicates just how much harder the Golf Course plays for any Average Golfer, i.e. not a Scratch Golfer.

Both worth mentioning can normally be found on the Golf Score Card, however in any other case, then simply ask on the Golf Course concerned.

When you have done this, take the card and subtract the suitable standard scratch score in the gross score that ended up being recorded. You now have 5 new totals. Have those 5 new totals and multiply by 113, that's the universal number used for Golf Association Handicaps. Right now, take the newest couple of totals, divide them by the slope rating figure of the proper course you're on. The next numbers that manifest is called your the game of golf differential.
