If the defects are minor, such as surface only , you might want to balance that against the price, and how significant you are as a player.

You'll need to still ensure that they don't contain major flaws, that may make the price that you pay is a waste of money. Only when the defect is slight and the price is low, will such a reduction golfing club prove to be a bargain buy.
