Every Beginner Should Have These Three Pieces of Golf Equipment

Many people think they need more equipment than they really do when they first start golfing. You won't need the fancy equipment until you've learned more about the basics of the game. You should invest in a good pair of golf shoes first. You'll be spending a lot of time on your feet as you play a game of golf so make sure the shoes you purchase fit your feet and are comfortable to wear. You can speed up the process of breaking in your new golf shoes by wearing them off the course or to the driving range. Your spikes will need to be appropriate for the courses that you'll play most often. Most courses in the U.S. require soft spike shoes, for example.

Ball markers are also important pieces of golf equipment to have.

This equipment is especially important if you play with a group. These markers help you identify the place where your ball landed and came to a stop on the green without interfering with the play of the other people playing the hole with you. Golf etiquette dictates that the person farthest from the hole plays first. This means that without a ball marker to mark your spot your ball could interfere with the play of the other ball or balls on the green. These inexpensive markers are necessary for a good game when playing with a group.

You will also need to invest in golf club head covers. You're investing time and money into assembling a good set of golf clubs. Even a beginners set of clubs can set you back a few hundred dollars - easily. Investing in quality golf head covers to protect them from banging together in your closet or in your car will prolong the life your clubs.

Because there are so many kinds of covers, you should be able to find ones that reflect your personal style.

Beginner golf equipment doesn't have to be expensive but if you buy the right equipment, it can add years of enjoyment to your game. Regardless if you're brand new to the game of golf or returning to it, all the fancy bells and whistles available can be distracting. You'll be in great shape, however, if you stick with the beginner golf equipment mentioned above.
