Boat And Lodging Packages

Everything from the boat to all necessary equipment will be supplied and all you'll need to do is show up and fish. Your fishing trip can be private or you can join a group of like-minded fishermen and make a party of it.

Explore Guatemala

You'll need a valid passport and it will be necessary to take a flight of two or more hours, depending on your starting point. Once you clear customs, the rest is easy. The abundance of billfish, mahi mahi, marlin, tuna and more is because of the coastline and the ecosystem in the area. Be sure to check the season for the fish you want and get there at the right time. The waters will be full of fish waiting for your line.
