The size of the hat is generally given on the inside. There are a wide range of sizes usable from child to adult, and they will be measured in both centimetres and inches. Normal sizes range from 49 to 65 cm or from 6 to 8 inches.

These days you are able to get riding hats in a variety of colors - not just black. When you select the right hat, you'll find it to be a comfortable and attractive horse riding accessory. The key is making sure that your hat fits correctly.

Generally, horse riding hats consist of a combination of materials such as fiber glass and plastic. Naturally, the materials used will vary from brand to brand. If you are buying your hat in person, which I recommend, you can ask the sales clerk to help you find the proper size. Sizes range from child to adult. Usually, adults wear a hat that is sized from six to eight inches.

There are a lot of benefits of horseback riding. First of all, this mode of exercise gives you a proper shape, for men and women equally. It possibly surprising to note, but horseback riding stimulates the same number of internal organs as walking on foot does, meaning an enhanced liver function and digestion.
