To maintain a swimming pool one needs to know all about water quality, about pool construction, cleaning and disinfecting [swimming pool chemicals](#) and general hygiene. The facility must be well cleaned absolutely imperatively to ensure that no one develops any water borne sickness. A regular schedule is chalked out so that there is no lapse in the cleaning of the pools. Even If the pools are not being used for some time the cleaning is still carried out and the pool is kept dry or even covered till its next use. Brominating or Chlorination is regularly affected and the water pH is maintained at a neutral state of 7.2 to 7.6.

Other steps include cleaning the skimmer baskets, providing and controlling algaecide and clarifiers, shock method of liberating free chlorine in the pool and some other minor treatments. The physical cleaning of the swimming pools takes place by employing skilled pool cleaners who ensure that the cleaning is done by brushing and vacuuming followed by drying and if possible protecting the pool with a special safety swimming pool covers. It is no wonder that expert swimmers who know all about swimming pools are thought to be the best people to maintain any quality swimming pool.
