To choose the board you should also know that there are different shapes of them. They are directional, twin-tip, twin-tip-directional, swallow's tail, All Mountain. It's better to define with shape of your future board directly at the store, because you should first see all that shapes and choose the best one for you.

If you still don't know what style and board to choose, it's better go to rent some kinds of boards first and only then go to the store. This purchase is rather expensive and it's better to know exactly what you need, not to waste money several times. If you rent some kinds of boards first, you will feel your kind of board yourself when you stand on it or try to ride.
