Soccer balls have three different size varieties. The smaller the size number, the smaller the ball is. The age is one of determining factors on which size suits to you. Ages 5-8 use size three, ages 9-12 use size four, and ages over 13 years old use size five. These are the widely recognized specifications for outdoor use. Soccer leagues have their own requirements with regards to soccer ball size used in matches. Oftentimes, these leagues use size 4 for indoor soccer matches. That's because indoor fields are smaller in area and consequently have a smaller goal.

It is essential to those who are new to soccer sport to have at least familiarize the differences in soccer ball size, so that when the time comes that you need to purchase one for yourself, you could have a greater chance of getting the right size of soccer ball. This is very important in order to avoid problems, especially when you are shopping for your soccer ball.

These problems usually arise if you have never experienced playing soccer since then. You may not be familiar about the different soccer ball size options available and so this may cause you some confusion. There are a few things in soccer ball size which are important for you to understand in order to make your shopping process as easy as possible.

Size 3 soccer balls weigh less than 1 pound with the circumference of about 24 inches. Size 4 balls are of the same weight as the size 3 balls, but slightly larger in circumference at about 26 inches. Size 5 are the largest size balls. These balls weigh about 1 pound with a circumference of about 28 inches. This is the approved international match ball standard.

Now, if you are planning to buy a soccer ball, you must determine first the purpose of buying that soccer ball. If you will be needing it for your practice, you need a smaller ball. If you intent to use in for your game, you will want a standard size for your age group.
