Within this , the first thing that you'll notice is that it has been designed to fulfill your wildest expectations on the a driver should really be like.

The engineers have designed this club to be among the lightest in the organization. The super ultra light edition is really a measly 276 Grams while the ultra light edition is only 310 grams. These are the almost all aerodynamic drivers in the game of golf. The head has recently been rightly shaped to minimize drag as the driver cuts through mid-air. Powered by the game's innovative lightweight shafts, the XCG\$ is truly an extended distance weapon off your tee. The heart of the XCG4 has a titanium deal with and sole. And has weight that is certainly perfectly positioned in underneath rear of the club to improve moment of inertia by over 15% in comparison with other versions! So which are the magical results? How about a extended tee shot that holds position even though the target line may be slightly off contact. That is the very powerful club.
